Camp Peniel Doctrinal Statement

We believe the Bible to be the verbally inspired Word of God, without error in the original writings, and the supreme and final authority in doctrine and practice and is made of the 66 books of the Old and New Testaments. (2 Timothy 3:16-17, 2 Peter 1:21, John 17:17, Matthew 5:18)

We believe in one personal and infinite God eternally existing in three equal persons; Father, Son and Holy Spirit; Who have the same nature and attributes but Who are distinct in office and activity. (Matthew 28:19, 2 Corinthians 13:14)

We believe that all things in heaven and on earth were created by God and exist by His power and for His glory. (Genesis 1:1, Colossians 1:16-17)

We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ is now in heaven, exalted at the right hand of God, where, as High Priest, He fulfills the ministry of intercession and advocacy for His people. (Hebrews 1:3, 3:1, 7:23-25, 1 John 2:1-2)

We believe that Satan, by his own choice the enemy of God and of the people of God, is the originator of sin. We believe he led our first parents, Adam and Eve, into sin and now rules as the god of this world. Satan was judged at the cross and ultimately he will be cast into the lake of fire for eternity. (Isaiah 14:12-14, Genesis 3:1-19, Hebrew 2:14, Revelation 20:10)

We believe that every Christian is called to fulfill the Commission given by Jesus Christ to His followers to "go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."
